2011 – 2012 Medical Documentation

MAKE YOUR DOCTOR'S APPOINTMENT NOW!

ALL STUDENTS ENTERING A NEW SCHOOL IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA MUST HAVE A PHYSICAL WITH AN EXAMINATION DATE AFTER AUGUST 21, 2010 COMPLETED BY A FLORIDA PHYSICIAN.

This is a Florida State law and no exceptions may be made.

In order to begin school in August, the following documents must be on file in the PJPII Clinic prior to the first day of school.

Both original Immunization and Physical Forms are only available from your physician.

1. Florida Certification of Immunization (Department of Health 680 Form)

- This *original blue* form is the *only* documentation that a school is permitted to accept as proof of immunizations.

To be valid, the 680 Form must include:

- Student's name, date of birth, and parent or guardian name
- Complete dates (month/day/year) for all immunizations
- The physician's signature, provider stamp and date in the appropriate section

The exemption date must be indicated for "Temporary Medical Exemption".

2. State of Florida School Entry Health Exam (Department of Health 3040 Form)

This *original yellow* form is only available from a physician. It includes:

- Part I: Child's Medical History completed by the child's parent or guardian
- Part II: Medical Evaluation completed by a Florida physician

To be valid, the 3040 Form must:

- Be signed and dated by a Florida physician
- Be the original yellow form

The physical will be valid for the entire school year.

If the student elects to play sports, a new physical will be required each school year.

Student-Athletes must have the following medical documentation on file in the Athletic Office at Pope John Paul II High School to be eligible to play a sport.

3. FHSAA Preparticipation Physical Evaluation EL2

(Department of Health 3040 Form may not be substituted for this physical form.)

The EL2 form must be completed, by your doctor, for students who will participate in sports during the **2011-2012** school year. You will receive this form in a separate mailing this month. If you require this document before that time, you can print it off the FHSAA website at: www.fhsaa.org under forms.
